Every day we shout unto the Lord singing and spreading the word of God to the people around us. What a wonderful plan the Lord had for us when He put you all into our lives to help make this ministry dream come true. Here are some stories about our life here. Anand, one of the children in our care, started listening to the word of God and gave his heart to Christ. When his father took him home for a couple of days, Anand told his dad about Jesus and shared Sunday school songs with him. God touched His father's heart and he accepted Jesus as his Saviour. Now we are praying for Anand's mother to come to the Lord.

Veeravathi is a lady who has helped us in our work. She came from a Hindu family but received the

Lord as a young lady. She is now 76 years old. All through her life she served the Lord visiting villages talking with people door to door. For four years she has been working with me and staying with us. Several days ago her relatives told me that they do not want to take any responsibility for her. Because she is a believer, if she dies, they do not want to come to her funeral. Now she is helpless. She cannot walk, hear or see properly. God never leaves those who trust Him so I feel it's my privilege to take care of her in her old age. This is the type of extra burden that we face.

Our neighbour Radhamma came to our worship service. After we shared about the Lord she started to believe. We have people who raise cattle coming and listening to the word of God. We are praying that the Lord will change their hearts too. We put a temporary road in our campus with rough sand and have ploughed some land to grow vegetables like tomatoes, eggplant, and green chillies.



### *Needs We are Facing*

With the new land comes new opportunity. We want to buy two cows, so we can provide our own milk for the children. This will provide a steady source of nourishment for them. For about \$1,500 we can get excellent animals. We will also have space to grow corn for the cattle so that will be a new expense. The third pressing need we have is for a fence to enclose the property. The fence will cost \$4,500. Of course those three things go together. Our other great need is for a decent four wheel drive truck. That will enable us to take the children where they need to go in an emergency and also give us a vehicle to help manage the needs of the small farm. We can get a good truck for about \$9000.

If you know of any churches, ladies groups, or missions minded people that I can talk to about our work, please let me know about them. We continue to seek more sponsorships for the children as there are many more who could be served.
